Additional Assessment Plan Tasks

Task: 1 Description: **Report an Emergency or Crime** Student will participate in a role play as the reporter of an emergency or crime. Content A (1 item, 2 points possible) Shown a picture or series of pictures depicting crimes or other emergencies, student will dial 911 or the non-emergency police number (whichever is appropriate to the situation) on a real or simulated telephone. Content B (13 items, 26 points possible)

Using the same picture or series of pictures used in Content A, student will report an emergency (BL-BH) or crime (IL-A). Examiner will play the role of the police dispatcher. Student will initiate or respond to up to 13 items such as: 1.state the emergency or crime,

- 2.-4. inititate or respond to up to 3 requests for personal information (name, phone number, address, etc.)
- 5.-13. answer up to 9 questions (BL-3, BH-4. IL-6, IH-A-9) about the incident and/or victim.

Sample questions:

- 1. What is the location?
- 2. Is the victim conscious?
- 3. Does the suspect have a gun?
- 4. What is happening at the scene now?

Note: Questions become increasingly more complex for the higher levels.
